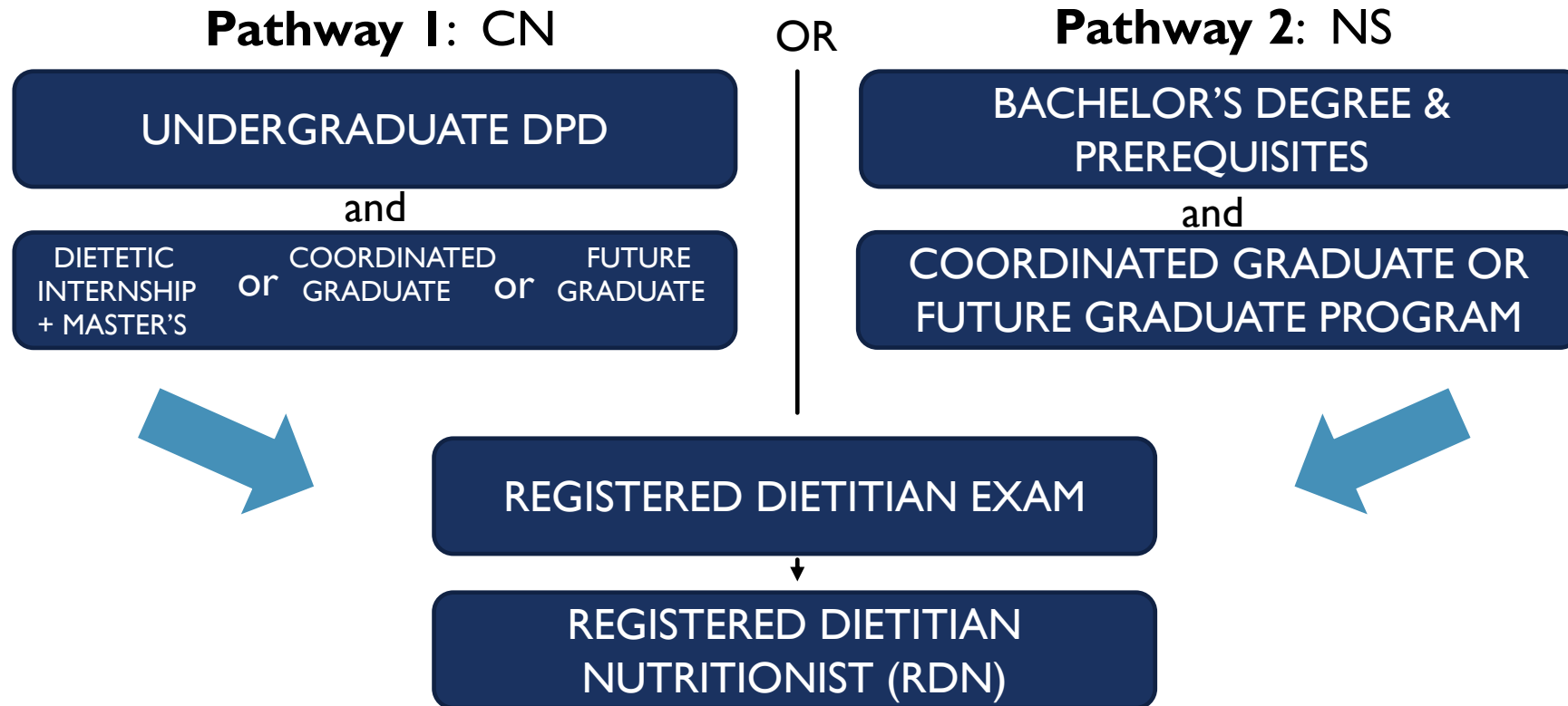

## DI APPLICATION PROCESS – 2 STEPS

1. DI Application – DICAS
2. Ranking & Match – D&D Digital

Coordinated/Future Graduate Programs:

- refer to their program websites OR DICAS



# APPLICATION PROCESS - DICAS

- Feb 15, 2023 is the deadline for the Spring Match
- Sept 25, 2023 is the deadline for the Fall Match
- NOTE: Some programs may have earlier deadlines!!!
- Fees:
  - \$50 for first program
  - \$25 each additional program
- DI program supplemental application packets
  - Fees, etc.



# THE MATCHING PROCESS – D&D

- Feb 15, 2023 is the deadline for the Spring Match
  - computer match in April
- Sept 25, 2023 is the deadline for the Fall Match
  - computer match in November
- Computer matching fee (\$65)
  - Select programs to which you're applying
  - Rank those programs
- Register online for the match:

Thurs. December 1

- Applicants may begin online matching registration on D&D

Wed. February 15

- DICAS & D&D Deadline for the match

Mon. March 20-27

- If desired, applicants may re-order online ranking list
- Deadline for withdrawing from Match 3/27

Sunday April 2

- Notification Day: Beginning 6:00 pm CDT

Monday April 3

- Appointment Day: Matched applicants must contact the DI

Wednesday, April 5

- DI Directors with openings contact unmatched applicants

Wednesday, April 5

- Names of DI programs with openings posted on D&D
- ISPPs open for application for unmatched applicants

- don't try to game the system



# COMPUTER MATCHING PROCESS

- Give permission to D&D to release your matching results –
  - If you don't get matched, then DIs can contact you if they have an opening
- After the match D&D will post list of DIs with vacancies –
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> round / ISPPs
