



- Deadlines vary
 - Fall before Nov. I
 - Spring before Mar. I
 - Many 12/1 or 12/15

Should not require decision before this date

Should not accept applications after this date **Spring**

March 1: Applicant

notification

March 15:

Should not require decision before this date

July 15:

Should not accept applications after this date







Individuals who already have a grad degree and DPD VS will complete the internship plus four classes in one year to receive a DI VS. Tuition is \$13,200 but subject to chang Those w/out a grad degree will need to complete the dept's MA in Family & Consumer Sci along w/ the DI to receive a DI VS. Tuition for MA/DI is \$19,672 (\$23,636 non-resident) & subject to change. The MA & DI require 1.5-2 yes to complete & may include summers. Typical active applicants have a strong DPD GPA, sig work/yol exp in dietetics or another area that provides transferable skills relevant to DI, & strong interpersonal & comm skills. Interns that are mature, motivated, flexible, interested in learning, & have strong time mingmt, interpersonal, & org skills are most successful. Applicants that are interested in working w/ diverse pops &/or billingual are encourage to apply. A car is rpd. A one hour commute each way to rotations can be expected as the norm. We have a supportive program director & long-time faculty. All rotations				


